

John's Dad was a priest, Paul was a Pharisee, Jesus was a carpenter. I, too, might have to change

Jesus, John, and Paul all worked in Troubled Times

The government was corrupt and ineffective, at the mercy of a distant country.

There were great inequalities of wealth and power.

This was a critical, pivotal, time in history.

John, Jesus, and Paul urged Repentance, Renewal, Revolution. What is the Spirit's prophetic message for Church and World? What is the Spirit's goal for ourselves and future generations? I must be the change-maker, do I need to change myself first?

Psalm 46:1-3

God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging If I stick to our mission, I have no need to fear

Isaiah 42:6-7

I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness;
I will take hold of your hand.
I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles,
to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness *I have a noble calling*

Mark 6.1-7

"Where did this man get these things?" they asked. "What's this wisdom that has been given him? What are these remarkable miracles he is performing? Isn't this the carpenter? "There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."

And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

... the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.

" "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. I baptize you with water

...he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit. Now is the time! Repent and do something about it!

The Bible

Psalm 91:1-16

...I will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday ...

Don't fear!

Isaiah 49:1-6

- ...He made me into a polished arrow and concealed me in his quiver
- ...I said, "I have laboured in vain; I have spent my strength for nothing at all
- ...And now the LORD says

...I will also make you a light for the Gentiles, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth" *Whoever limited I feel, I can stick up for the right and good*

Mark 13:1-13

"You must be on your guard. You will be handed over to the local councils and flogged in the synagogues. On account of me you will stand before governors and kings as witnesses to them. And the gospel must first be preached to all nations. Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit Jesus showed the disciples how to speak

Psalm 116:1-19

I will sacrifice a thank offering to you and call on the name of the LORD. I will fulfil my vows to the LORD in the presence of all his people, in the courts of the house of the LORD Show your gratitude for every blessing

Isaiah 58:1-12

If you do away with the yoke of oppression, with the pointing finger and malicious talk, and if you spend yourselves in behalf of the hungry and satisfy the needs of the oppressed, then your light will rise in the darkness, and your night will become like the noonday.


...You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail. Your people will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up the age-old foundations; you will be called Repairer of Broken Walls, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings.

Don't pay lip service to God, take on board his concern for injustice

Mark 5:21-43

He took her by the hand and said to her "Little girl, I say to you, get up!". Immediately the girl stood up and began to walk around...At this they were completely astonished. He ...told them to give her something to eat

The rich man's daughter has the same value as the poor widow



Although the rich man was a stranger, and Jesus thought he was on the wrong path, nevertheless Jesus loved him

Jesus advocated a simple lifestyle

What luxuries are part of my life at expense to Planet Earth?

What do I understand by the phrase "Non-essential shopping"?

How much of it do I do?

God's ways are so different. Am I prepared to stand out as different from my non-Christian neighbours?

If I was suspected of being a Christian, would a jury find enough evidence to convict me?

Will I allow the Spirit to teach me to read the teaching of Jesus with an open mind?

Psalm 100

Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs Whatever is happening, can I find something to rejoice about?

Isaiah 55:8-11

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways The ways of a good life are different from the ways of a quiet life

Mark 14:32-52

"Simon," he said to Peter, "are you asleep? Couldn't you keep watch for one hour? Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak."

...Now the betrayer had arranged a signal with them: "The one I kiss is the man; arrest him and lead him away under guard." Going at once to Jesus, Judas said, "Rabbi!" and kissed him. The men seized Jesus and arrested him

Jesus wanted to avoid his trials but was obedient to His calling

Judas betrayed Jesus with a kiss

When I say "I love you" does it ring true?

When I say I love the Lord, does it show in my life?

In my life, is there enough praise?

Can I understand prayer as being at one with God's Spirit?

Psalm 8

...what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?
You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honour.
You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet:
all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild, the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.

LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You are custodians, you are important, be thoughtful in your actions

Isaiah 61:1-6

The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor God's ways are so different from the path I am treading just now

Mark 10:17-31

Jesus looked at him and loved him. "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

At this the man's face fell. He went away sad, because he had great wealth

Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God!" Earthly treasure is an illusion

Psalm 133:1-3

How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity People living and working together peacefully is true worship

Isaiah 65:17-25

See, I will create new heavens and a new earth. The former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind

...They will neither harm nor destroy on all my holy mountain Isaiah had a vision of what he wanted Israel to be like

Mark 9:30-50

They left that place and passed through Galilee. Jesus did not want anyone to know where they were, because he was teaching his disciples...

Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, "Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all."

..."Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again?

Time spent getting all the team on the same page is time well spent
